ORDER

Sub: Dispensing away with the services of Principals/Vice-Principals/ Teachers of Private Unaided Recognized Schools of Delhi.

It has come to the notice of the department that managements of some Private Unaided Recognized Schools have extended the services of Principals/Vice-Principals/Teachers working in their school even after attaining the age of 60 years, in violation of Rule 110 (3) of DSEAR, 1973.

Rule 110(2) Provides as under:

“Notwithstanding anything contained in sub rule (1), every teacher, Laboratory Assistant, Librarian, Principal or Vice-Principal employed in such school shall continue to hold office until he attains the age of 60 years.”

Rule 110(3) provides that - Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1) and sub-rule (2), where a teacher, Principal or Vice Principal has obtained National or State award for rendering meritorious service as a teacher, Principal or Vice Principal or where he has received both the National and State awards as aforesaid, the period of service of such teacher, Principal or Vice Principal may be extended by such period as the Administrator may, by general or special order, specify in this behalf.


Under the provisions of Rule 110(3) of DSEAR, 1973, Directorate of Education issued a Notification No.F.33 (17)/Edn./96/903-920 dated 16-08-2008 directing the managements of the Private Unaided recognized Schools to seek approval of Administrator for extension of the services of their Principal/Vice-Principals/Teachers who are State/National/Padma Shree/Padma Bhushan/Padma Vibhushan Awardees.

The violation made by schools in this regard has been viewed very seriously by this Directorate.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the undersigned under section 24(3) of Delhi School Education Act, 1973, the managements of all the Private Unaided recognized schools are hereby directed to immediately apply in accordance with circular dated 16.08.2008 within a period of 30 days of issuance of this circular for decision of Administrator regarding extension. In case no application is made within this time period, the management Committee must dispense away with the services of such Principals with immediate effect. A compliance report shall be submitted within 15 days thereafter in this regard to the district authorities concerned.


