### **ENGLISH**

#### **SOCIAL SCIENCE**

India's struggle for freedom was a long and arduous journey, marked by countless sacrifices and unwavering determination. From the Revolt of 1857 to the Quit India Movement of 1942, Indians fought tirelessly against British colonial rule, driven by a shared vision of independence and self governance. Led by iconic figures like Mahatma Gandhi, Jawaharlal Nehru, and Subhash Chandra Bose, the freedom struggle employed various methods, including non-violent resistance, civil disobedience, and armed rebellion. The collective efforts of countless freedom fighters, activists, and ordinary citizens ultimately led to India's independence on August 15, 1947, a momentous occasion that marked a new era of freedom, democracy, and self-determination for the nation.

Prepare a detailed project in a Project file or on coloured A4 size sheets on the topic "India's Quest for Freedom: A Historic Journey".

You can include these points in your project:

### 1.Important Events and Movements

- Indian Rebellion of 1857: Describe the significance of this event, which marked the beginning of India's struggle for independence.

- Swadeshi Movement: Discuss the movement's emphasis on self-reliance and boycott of British goods.
- Purna Swaraj: Explain the demand for complete independence from British rule, which gained momentum in the 1920s.

### 2. Freedom Fighters

- Rani Lakshmibai: Highlight her bravery during the Indian Rebellion of 1857, particularly the Siege of Jhansi.
- Bhagat Singh: Describe his revolutionary activities, including the Lahore Conspiracy Case and Assembly Bombing.
- Lala Lajpat Rai: Examine his protests against the Simon Commission and his contributions to the freedom struggle.

#### 3.Leaders and their Movements:

- Mahatma Gandhi: Explore his non-violent resistance methods, notable movements like the Non Cooperation Movement, Civil Disobedience Movement, and Quit India Movement.
- Subhash Chandra Bose: Discuss his role in the Indian National Army (INA), and his efforts to liberate India from British rule.

### 4. Other Important Figures

- Bal Gangadhar Tilak: Discuss his advocacy for Swaraj (self-rule) and his leadership in the Swadeshi Movement and Home Rule Movement.
- Gopal Krishna Gokhale: Describe his role as a mentor to Mahatma Gandhi and his contributions to the Indian National Congress

(Note: you are free to include any other relevant topic/topics)

The Project should be Handwritten. Presentation should be good, be creative, handwriting should be neat and paste pictures relevant to the topic.

OR

Create a 3D model on any one of the following topics

- 1. **Natural Resources:** Create a 3D model showcasing different types of natural resources, such as:
- Forests (using green clay or cardboard trees)
- Water bodies (using blue clay or a small water container)
- Minerals (using rocks or mineral samples)
- Fossil fuels (using small containers or models of oil rigs)

- 2. **Resource Conservation:** Create a 3D model demonstrating ways to conserve resources, such as:
- Recycling (using recycled materials and creating a recycling centre)
- Water conservation (using a small model of a rainwater harvesting system)

#### Case Study based question (submit hard copy):


- Q5. Design a network infrastructure for a small business or organization.
