## **ACTIVITY TIME**

Hand printing activity:- Things needed:- Green poster colour and decoration material

1. Apply green poster colour to your right palm.

2. Make a handprint in the space given below.

3. Add details (eyes, mouth, etc.) to transform the handprint into an alligator.

- Alligators can live both on land and in water.

## **BUTTERFLY**


#### ACTIVITY TIME

- Butterflies never sleep in their lifetime, as they do not have eyelids.










#### **CAMEL**

- Camels are herbivorous animals (plant eaters) and like to eat grass, leaves and twigs.










<u>DUCK</u>

## **ACTIVITY TIME**


**<u>Rhyme Time</u>:-** Let's learn and recite the Elephant rhyme with actions. Link of the rhyme is given below:-

- Elephants are the largest land animals on the Earth because of their massive size, long trunk, big tusks (teeth) and big ears.
- They live in forests and grasslands and travel in groups called herds.
- Elephants have sharp memory and are very caring.
- Elephants are herbivorous animals (plant eaters) and like to eat grass, leaves and twigs.



- Flamingos live in big, shallow salt lakes.
- They are omnivorous animals (they eat both plants and animals). For example tiny bugs, shrimps, seeds and algae.










## <u>GORILLA</u>

**Story Time:-** Enjoy story time with your family.



- They have long ears and big feet for running fast.






#### **IGUANA**

#### ACTIVITY TIME


**Paper tearing and pasting activity:**- Things needed:- Green and yellow colour paper and glue.

- They are omnivorous animals (they eat both plants and animals) and like to eat fruits, berries, dead animals, birds, etc.










## <u>KOALA</u>

## **ACTIVITY TIME**


**Paper tearing and pasting activity:-** Things needed:-Brown and green colour paper and glue.

- Paste them on Koala slowly and gently.




- Koalas live in eucalyptus forests in Australia.

- Leopards are carnivorous animals (flesh eating animals) and eat meat like deer, monkey and birds.










#### **MONKEY**

- Monkeys eat fruits, leaves and insects.










## <u>NYALA</u>




- Penguins are flightless seabirds adapted to a marine lifestyle in the Southern Hemisphere.

- They feed on seafood like krill, fish, and squid.



#### **QUAILS**

- Quails are small birds with short, round bodies and short tails.
- Quails are omnivorous, but they eat mostly plants. They love seeds, grains, leaves and berries and they also eat insects like grasshoppers and worms.
- Quails live in a variety of habitats like fields, grasslands and wooded areas.










## <u>RABBIT</u>

#### **ACTIVITY TIME**

**Cotton pasting activity:-** Let's use cotton to make a fluffy rabbit. Colour the image and paste cotton to make a soft bunny rabbit.



- Rabbits are small animals, known for their long ears and fluffy tails.
- They are herbivorous and eat mainly plants like grass and carrot.
- They are social animals that live in groups and dig burrows underground for shelter.

- Snails are small, soft-bodied animals with a spiral shell for protection.
- They move slowly and have a long, soft body with no legs. Snails eat plants and have a special tooth-like organ called a radula to grind their food.
- They leave a slimy trail as they move.



- They are carnivores (flesh eating animals) and eat meat like deer, wild boars, rabbits etc.









## <u>URCHIN</u>

## ACTIVITY TIME

## Craft activity:- Paper cup Urchin

Things needed:- Paper cup, water colours, scissors, black sketch pen/marker and paint brush.

#### Step by step instructions to make Urchin:-

- Take a paper cup and paint it inside out.
- After the cup dries, use scissors to cut Urchin's spikes.
- Cut till the bottom of the cup.
- Gently press the spikes down.
- On the base of the cup, make the face of the Urchin (eyes and mouth with black sketch pen) as shown in the picture.
- Urchin is ready!



- An urchin is a spiky, round sea creature. They live in the ocean and have a hard shell with spines.
- Urchins use their spines to move and protect themselves.
- They eat seaweed and other plants in the ocean.








## <u>VULTURE</u>

#### ACTIVITY TIME

**Maze hunt:-** Help the vulture find its way through the maze to get back to its nest. Start at the vulture and follow the path to the nest.




- Vultures are big birds with strong wings!
- Vultures are scavenging birds that feed on carrion (dead flesh of animals).
- They have sharp beaks and strong talons, perfect for tearing flesh.
- Vultures are essential environmental clean-up crews, removing dead animals and preventing the spread of diseases.
- Vultures have exceptional eyesight, spotting a prey from great heights.



- Walruses are big, friendly sea creatures that live in the Arctic Ocean.
- They have thick, brown skin and long, white tusks that help them dig for food and climb out of the water.
- They eat clams and other sea creatures, and they are known for their loud calls, which can be heard from far away.





## X-RAY FISH

#### **ACTIVITY TIME**


Hand printing activity:- Things needed:- white sheet, water colours, googly eye, scissors, glue.

#### Step by step instructions to make X-ray fish:-

- Take a white plain sheet
- Spread black paint on the hand and press it on the sheet as shown in the picture.
- Cut out triangle from paper for the head and strips of paper for the skeleton body.
- Paste the cutouts as shown in the picture.



- The X-ray fish has a transparent body that glows in the dark.
- They live in South America and are friendly fish, often kept in aquariums.
- They are omnivorous, they eat both plants and animals.




<u>YAK</u>

**Wool pasting activity:-** Things needed:- Brown wool, scissors, glue, colours. **Step by step instructions:**-

- Colour the face of Yak.
- Cut strings of wool (preferably brown colour).
- Apply glue on the body of yak and paste strings of wool on it.




- Yaks are large, shaggy Ox-like animals native to the mountainous regions of Asia.
- They are primarily herbivorous, grazing on grasses and leaves in their highaltitude habitats.
